## Who is NBBCMinistry?

New Berean Baptist was founded by Leroy E. Ricks in the fall of 1989. He answered the call of God by faith and along with two other men and their families began this new work, a ministry, and local New Testament church committed to the preaching and teaching of the Word of God. Pastor Ricks, as he was commonly called, wanted New Berean to be a local church assembly "Committed to the Commission of Christ" of Matthew 28:18-20 by teaching and preaching God's word to those who would hear, baptize those who believe and be a training facility for those who will follow.

# The Bereans Are Noble

The name New Berean is derived from Acts 17:11 where a group of Christians were described being more noble than the brethren in the Thessalonian community. Their nobility is attributed to their diligence to hear the word being taught and searching the scripture manuscripts for their biblical authenticity. In doing so, they were able to validate, support or reject that which they had heard.

The members of New Berean are expected in all cases, all instances to validate any teaching or preaching of the word of God. Sound preaching and teaching is of the utmost importance and is why we encourage searching of

the scriptures. There are many doctrines in the world today and many people are being deceived and led incorrectly. It is important what we hear because it leads to what we believe and what we be believe can have a bearing on our eternal end and obedience to the Lord.

## New Berean's Basic Beliefs

New Berean Baptist Church accepts the Holy Bible, both the Old and New Testaments as the authoritative, inspired word of God. It is in these sacred scriptures that we agree to the following as the basic foundation of the Christian faith:

- We believe there is only one living God existing in three distinct role or persons - the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. These three persons are the Triune Godhead of one essence having the same nature, perfection and attributes. (1 Tim 2:5)
- We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God, came into the world that He might manifest God to men, fulfill prophecy, and become the Redeemer of a lost world (Jn 1:1-13). To this end, He was born of the Virgin Mary, received a human body and a sinless human nature without ceasing to be God.
- We believe the gospel of Jesus Christ to be that Christ willingly died, was buried and was raised from the dead three days later as complete satisfaction of God for the sin debt of mankind. This debt was a result of the first man, Adam disobeying God's word and suffering the result – death. His death cast a curse on all of humanity (Rom 5:12)
- We believe the Lord Jesus established an institution to fulfill the mission He started (Matt 16:18). The New Testament church body (1 Cor 12:12) is made up of people who are born-again believers, water baptized and commissioned to follow his commandment to make disciples throughout the whole world (Matt 28:18-20).

We believe salvation is the end result of a person accepting the truth of God's word as it relates to their sinful condition (Rom 3:10, 23 & 5:12) and God extending his grace of reconciliation (Rom 5:8). Salvation is the redemption, regeneration, sanctification, and glorification of one who is saved (Rom 8:28-30). We believe that salvation is wholly by the grace of God, not to be merited and is eternally secure (Eph 2:8-10)
